- Technology is enabling fraudsters to carry out attacks quicker and employ more complex behaviours to remain undetected.

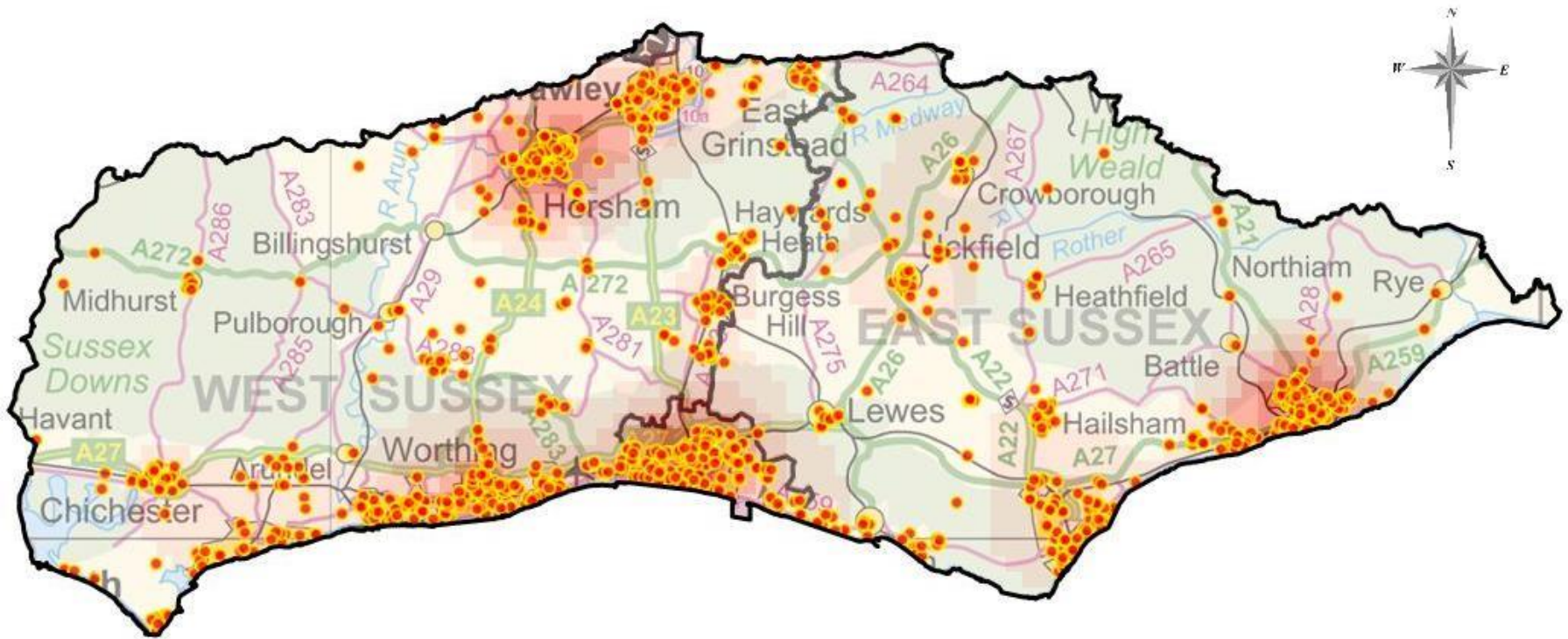


Tom Beckett from West Sussex sent over £100,000 to fraudsters

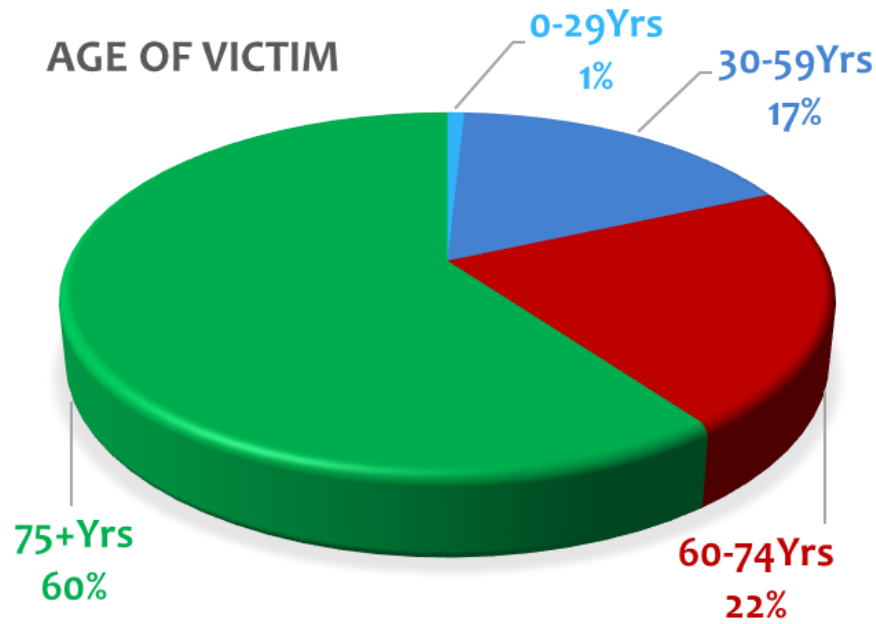
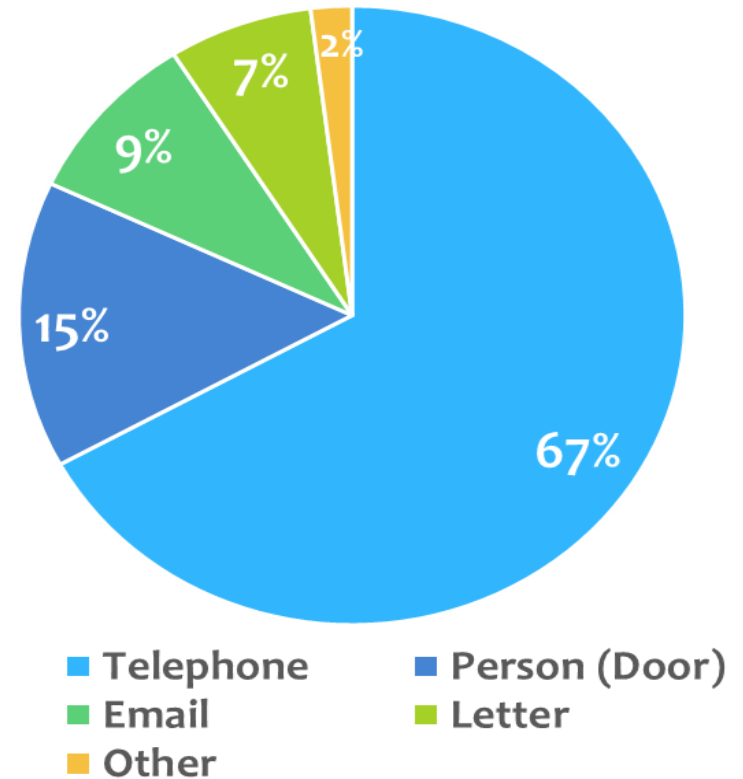


Sussex Profile

Over 3500 Op Signature reports have been created since it's introduction

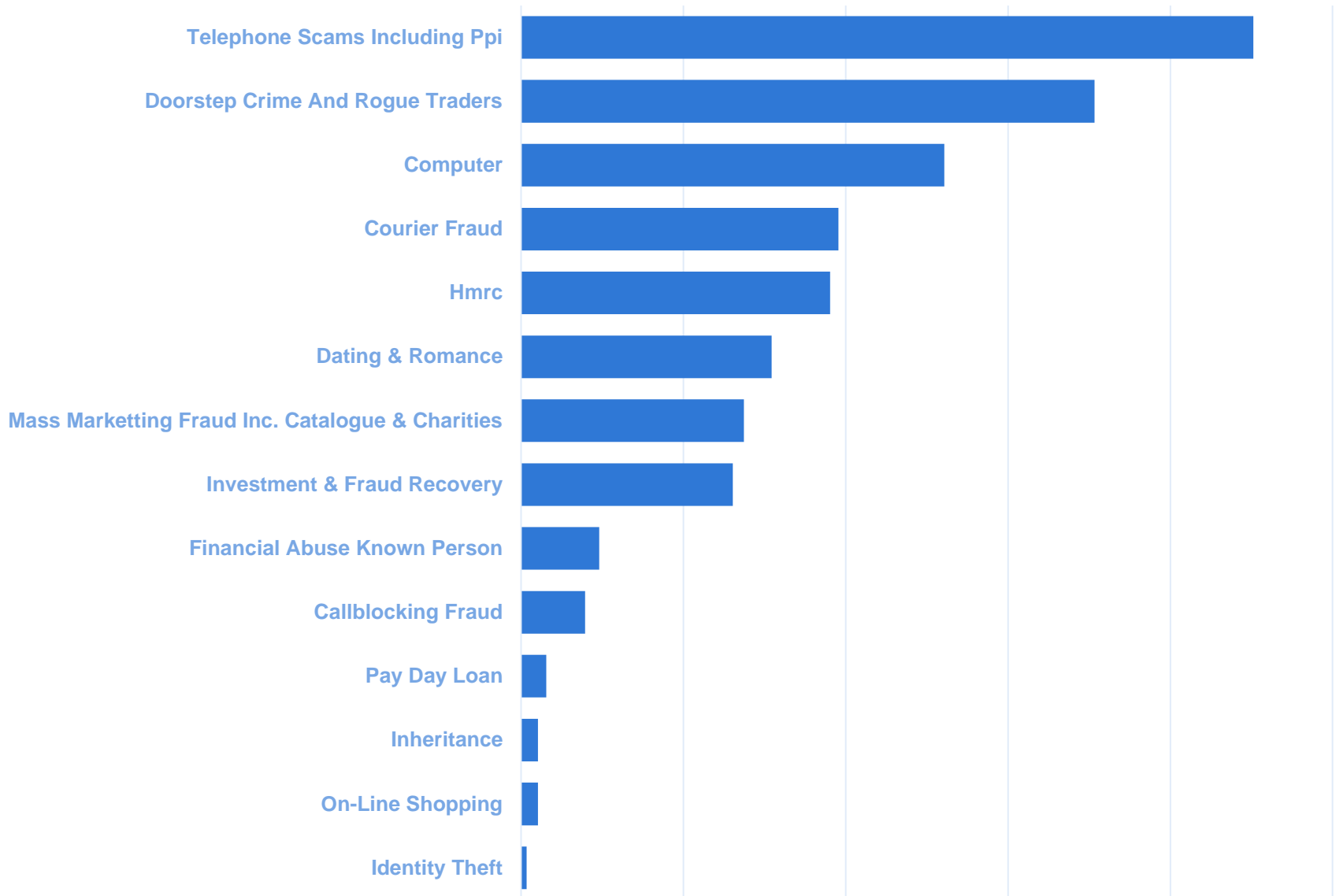


Method of Contact

Fraud types



The initiative was started throughout Sussex at the start of June. In the first 12 months:

- 300 calls were received from the banks
- 200 crimes reported
- 200 concerns for adults recorded
- 19 arrests were made
- Prevented financial losses to victims :
£1,347,331
- The victim's average age: 76

Call blocking technology

- 170 trueCall Call blockers have been installed in the homes of the most vulnerable
- 71,000 nuisance calls blocked
- Receiving nominations from partner agencies
- 3 years monitoring reports to share Intelligence with NFIB
